Dear Parents,

Re: Dedicated Dance Show - Sweetshop

Thank you so much for your overwhelming interest in the show. I am now writing with further details so that everyone will know what is going on! **Firstly, anyone who has not yet replied and payment made, please do so before Saturday 12th March so that costumes and dances may be finalised. If you have not replied by then I will assume that you do not wish your child to take part in the show. If I have not received payment I will assume your child has changed their mind and is not in the show.**

I am in need of helpers for both performances and dress rehearsal for all groups; – if you can help please speak to Megan (Saturday) or Myself.

Tickets are now on sale. They will be £6 each. Two tickets per student have been allocated; **if you have not stated which performance you would like please let me know or you might not get the performance you want** as there are only 100 tickets for each performance. Spare tickets will be sold on a first come first served basis. **Please bring payment for tickets in an envelope marked with the students name and the number of tickets required.** Please note that although the tickets are numbered the seats are not allocated – you may sit on any chair! There are no concessions, if a child cannot sit on a lap they will require a ticket.

Each student will be loaned a costume for the event. They will be given out the week before the dress rehearsal. They will be the students responsibility and will be collected at the end of the show. Each student should bring their costume to the dress rehearsal and show (**the costume should be handed back after the second show so please bring a change of clothes**). Also please ensure that the performers bring their ballet shoes, Grade Two Tuesday and Grade 5 need Character shoes. Pre Primary, Primary Saturday, Grade 1 and 2 need pink ballet socks. Primary Wednesday will have white tights included in their costume. Grade 3+ need ballet tights (Boys black or white ballet shoes and white socks). Grade 7, 8 & pointe need black tights – included in the the costume.

On the day of the show please name everything if you wish it to be returned - things get lost! Your child should bring a book or other quiet pastime for when they are not dancing – **No paints or felt pens please.** Also, please give your child a packed snack/ dinner so that they can eat between performances. **No chocolate or fizzy drinks** – they do not mix well with ballet costumes! Any costumes that are lost or damaged will be charged for.

Dress Rehearsal – The dress rehearsal will take place on Saturday 26th March at Queen Ediths School (parking on the school playground off Godwin Way), please come to the Large Hall – where the show will be. The dress rehearsal is designed to put the dancers at ease so they are used to their surroundings and what they are required to do. It will also give them a

chance to see the other performers. Please, if you are not a designated helper, leave your child with their group and return to collect your child at the designated time. As you will appreciate space and time are short, and numbers, noise and excitement levels need to be kept to a minimum.

Dress rehearsal times (26th March) - Please read carefully!

3rd	5 - 6pm	Adults

On Saturday 2nd April (Show Day) as you know there will be two performances - all dancers will be in both performances. The dancers should arrive with their costume at the following times and report to the front desk, no parents back stage please (unless a designated helper);

1pm	Pre Primary Saturday, Primary Saturday, Grade 2 Wednesday, Grade 3, 4, 5, 6 and Pointe and Jessica
1.30pm	Pre Primary Monday, Primary Wednesday, Grade 7 and 8. Lucy B and Vesna

The **first performance is at 2pm the second at 4pm**. Doors will open at 1.30pm for the first show and 3:30pm for the second. If young children are watching the show and require a chair they must have a ticket.

Please no flash photography during performances, it is very off-putting for performers and audience. If you wish to take video we ask that you stand at the back so others can see the stage. Please ensure that all mobile phones and cameras etc have been switched to silent, if you cannot do this please do not use it. No photographs containing children other than your own must be shared on social media.

Photographs will be taken of all groups during the dress rehearsal and on the show day which will be available to view and buy. A DVD of the show will be available to order at the show, priced £15.

Finally, I will be holding a Raffle in the interval to raise money for the **East Anglia Children's Hospice**. If you would like to donate a prize, such as a bottle of wine, toiletries, chocolates, toys etc. please bring it to a class before the 30th March, and hand it to me or Megan!

If you have any questions please check the website under 'show' or the notice board. If you do not find the answer there then please ask me. I hope that the show will be a great success and I am looking forward to seeing you all there! Thank you again for your enthusiasm and patience!

I am encouraging mask wearing at the rehearsals, back stage and in the audience. We will continue to open windows for ventilation and hope that everyone will be happy and safe for our performance.
